PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION/PROPERTIES: Amber coloured viscous liquid consisting of an aqueous solution of the following surface active agents: Alkyl Diethanolamide, Nonyl Phenyl Ethoxylates, Alkanolamine Soaps. Free Alkanolamine. pH: 10.0

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

HEALTH EFFECTS:

Considered to be practically non harmful by all exposure routes. Contact with skin will result in mild irritation. Repeated or prolonged skin contact may lead to dermatitic effects. Will have a degreasing action on the skin. Industrial experience has demonstrated skin sensitisation in some individuals. Likely to be a moderate to severe eye irritant.

FIRST AID:

SWALLOWED: Give water or milk to drink and induce vomiting. Use fingers in the throat or Ipecac Syrup (APF). Seek immediate medical assistance.

EYE: Immediately irrigate with copious quantities of water for at least 15 minutes. Eyelids to be held open. In all cases of eye contamination it is a sensible precaution to seek medical advice.

SKIN: Wash contaminated skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If irritation occurs seek medical advice.

INHALED: Remove victim from exposure.
